III >> REGISTRATION AND ELIGIBILITY: Registration will be Saturday morning from 9:00 to 11:00 a.m. This event is open to all Laser Members.

IV >> RULES: This event will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012. This includes US Sailing Prescriptions and the Rules of the International Laser Class Association. Rules may also be changed by the sailing instructions.

V >> SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Sailing instructions will be available during on-site registration and on-line at <http://d21.laserforum.org/index.html> regatta two days before the event.

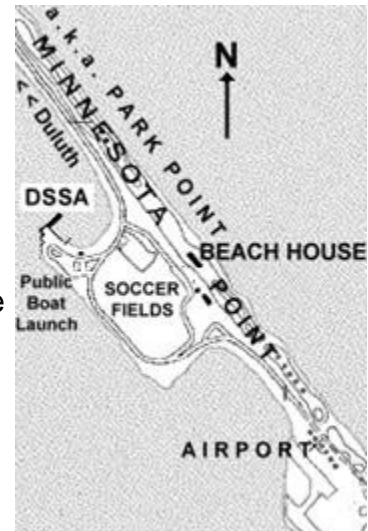
VI >> LOCATION: 5000 Minnesota Avenue, Duluth 55802 (Regatta Headquarters)

Directions

From downtown Duluth, cross the Duluth Lift Bridge in Canal Park. Travel on Minnesota Avenue past curve and through the stop sign. Continue past Lafayette Community Center on the left and past the Rowing Club and Southworth Marsh on the right.

Enter the Park Point Recreation Area. The road curves to the right. Pass the playground on the left and the restrooms on the right. Keep right and enter the parking lot for the public boat launch.

Our site is on the pier adjacent to the boat launch. If the road curves to the left again or you arrive at the airport, you have gone too far.



VII >> COURSES: Primarily Windward/Leeward, but other courses may be used as indicated in the Sailing Instructions. No minimum course length.

Races will be sailed on Lake Superior in front of the Beach House or St. Louis Bay in front of the Sailing Pier as weather permits.

VIII >> FLEETS/CLASSES: Laser Full Rig
Laser Radial (if 4 or more registered)
Laser 4.7 (if 4 or more registered)

IX >> RACES SCHEDULED AND SCORING: 9 races are scheduled and 1 race completed will constitute a regatta. Scoring will be per RRS Appendix A, Low-point system – each boat's series score will be the total of his/her race scores. If 6 races are completed, the worst score will be excluded.

X >> AWARDS: Top 3 Places overall, Top Junior, Top Female, Top Master, Top DSSA Member (and if 4 or more in a fleet – Top Radial and Top 4.7)

XI >> WATER BOTTLES: Please bring reusable water bottles. Refills will be available on a support boat.

XII >> DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY: Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
